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2008 Mural Contest Rules for Grades K-8th

Sponsored by: **UMPQUA BANK**

1. Mural must portray the 2008 Conference theme: "**Logging, Living & Learning** "
2. Mural must be created on wood pulp sheets provided by the Conference. **ONE PULP SHEET PER CLASSROOM.**
3. Murals may be created using crayons, watercolors, poster paints, paper collage and other unique materials. Use your imagination! **Remember, murals will be hung on a wall for display.** Murals that are not appropriately designed for wall hanging will be disqualified.
4. Murals will be judged on the use of the conference theme, creative use of materials and whole class participation. The murals should be age appropriate with work done by the students and innovated uses of wood products and design. The murals should be a learning experience for students; demonstrating an understanding of the interrelationship between the forest and human communities; the renewal ability over time of a managed forest; and the many people working together to fulfill the importance of the demand of wood products in our everyday lives.
5. The teacher's name, grade, school, and telephone number must be on the inside of a 3x5 card folded in half and stapled shut to the **bottom right-hand corner** of the mural. The **outside** of that card should show **only** the grade level.
6. The murals will be divided into two grade categories for judging: K-3rd grades and 4th-8th grades. If you have a 3/4 combination, the mural will be judged in the 4th-8th grade category. Prizes for winning murals in each category are: First Place: \$300; Second Place: \$200; Third Place: \$100; and five Honorable Mentions at \$50 each. **ADDITIONALLY, EVERY CLASS WHO ENTERS A MURAL WILL RECEIVE A \$50.00 CASH AWARD FOR THEIR COMPLETED ENTRY.**
7. Murals must be received for judging no later than **Friday, March 14, 2008 at 5 PM.** Please deliver your completed mural to one of the following locations:

10. Any mural, which is determined by the RRLC Education Committee to be inappropriate, will be disqualified, will not be displayed at the conference, and will not receive the \$50.00 cash prize. **HAVE FUN!**
