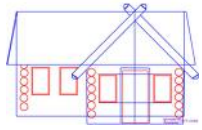

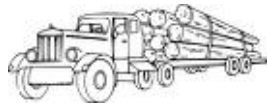
### **11:00 AM PORTABLE SAWMILL EXHIBITION**

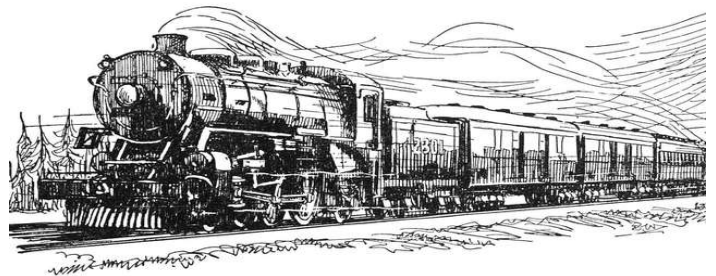

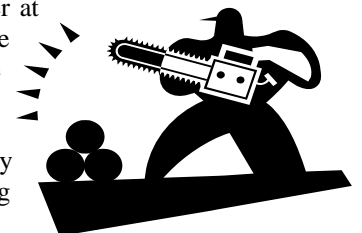
