*Multiple scholarships will be awarded to graduating High School Seniors in Humboldt, Del Norte, Trinity, Lake, and Mendocino Counties who will be enrolled in a Forestry or Natural Resource field of study to include (but not limited to) **Forestry, Environmental Studies, Surveying, Wildlife Biology, Fisheries, or a related vocational training program such as Diesel Mechanics or Equipment Operator School.***

Requirements

1. Completed & signed Redwood Region Logging Conference's 2026 High School Forestry & Natural Resource **Scholarship Application**.
2. **Cover Letter** – Write a Cover Letter (1 page MAX) describing yourself and why you should be considered for this scholarship. Ideas to include are, but are NOT limited to, present and future goals, reasons for major choice and school, how you associate with the Timber Industry, leadership experience, and honors & recognition you have received. Please use 11-point font and print on ONE side of the page only.
3. Questions - Address the topics provided to the best of your ability in your **cover letter**.
4. One **letter of recommendation**
5. **Photo**- Please email a current photo of yourself in .jpg format to rrlc@sonic.net. Your photo will be used for promotional purposes only. The Scholarship Committee does not have access to the images. Printed photos will not be accepted.
6. **Unofficial High School Transcript** – Graduating High School Seniors need to send an unofficial high school transcript (minimum 2.0 to qualify).

All material should be postmarked, hand-delivered, or emailed no later than 5:00 pm, April 1, 2026

Applicants will be contacted by mail with the results. Award presentation(s) will take place during Senior Awards Programs at the applicant's high school.
