#### 2024 Mural Contest Rules & Info for Grades K-8th

- 1. The mural must portray the 2024 Conference theme: "GROWING A STRONGER INDUSTRY FOR THE NEXT GENERATION, ONE TREE AT A TIME."
- 2. A mural must be created on the wood pulp sheet provided to schools by the Conference. Only one pulp sheet will be provided per classroom.
- 3. Murals may be created using crayons, watercolors, paint, paper collages, or any other unique materials. Use your imagination! Remember, murals will be hung on a wall for display. Murals that are not appropriately designed for wall hanging will not be judged or displayed due to lack of space.
- 4. Murals will be judged on the use of the conference theme, creative use of materials, and whole class participation. The murals should be age-appropriate with work done by the students with innovative uses of wood products in the design. The murals should be a learning experience for students; demonstrating an understanding of the relationship between the forest and everyday life; the sustainability of a managed forest; and the many people working together to fulfill the importance of the demand for wood products in our lives.
- 5. The teacher's name, grade, school, and telephone number must be on a 3x5 card secured flat on the **bottom right-hand corner** of the mural, facing up with the writing visible. (Please do not fold and staple)
- 6. Each class not receiving a winning cash prize will **RECEIVE \$50!**
- 7. **PRIZES:** The murals will be divided into two grade categories for judging: K-3<sup>rd</sup> grades and 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades. If you have a 3/4 combination, the mural will be judged in the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade category. Prizes for winning murals in each category are:

**HUMBOLDT/DELNORTE/TRINITY COUNTIES**: First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; and three Honorable Mention of \$75 each for both age categories. (*Note: Classes winning Cash Prizes will not receive an additional \$50 Participation Incentive.*)
