## **2023 Mural Contest Rules & Info for Grades K-8<sup>th</sup>**

- 1. Mural must portray the 2023 Conference theme: “TECHNOLOGY DRIVEN - LEGACY HONORED.”** Possible Careers: Forester, Fishery or Wildlife Biologist, Equipment Operator, Yarder Engineer, Logger, Tree Faller, Mill Worker, Welder, Mechanic, Truck Driver, Tree Planter, Drone Pilot, etc.
- Mural must be created on the wood pulp sheet provided to schools by the Conference. Only one pulp sheet will be provided per classroom.
- Murals may be created using crayons, watercolors, paint, paper collage, or any other unique materials. Use your imagination! Remember, murals will be hung on a wall for display. Murals that are not appropriately designed for wall hanging will not be judged or displayed due to lack of space.
- Murals will be judged on the use of the conference theme, creative use of materials, and whole class participation. **The murals should be age appropriate with work done by the students with innovated uses of wood products in the design.** The murals should be a learning experience for students; demonstrating an understanding of the relationship between the forest everyday life; the sustainability of a managed forest; and the many people working together to fulfill the importance of the demand of wood products in our lives.
- The teacher’s name, grade, school, and telephone number must be on a 3x5 card secured flat on the **bottom right-hand corner** of the mural, facing up with the writing visible. (Please do Not fold and staple)
- Each class not receiving a winning cash prize will **RECEIVE \$50!**
- PRIZES: The murals will be divided into two grade categories for judging:** K-3<sup>rd</sup> grades and 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades. If you have a 3/4 combination, the mural will be judged in the 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade category. Prizes for wining murals in each category are:

**HUMBOLDT/DELNORTE/TRINITY COUNTIES:** First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; and three Honorable Mention of \$75 each for both age categories. (*Note: Classes winning Cash Prizes will not receive an additional \$50 Participation Incentive.*)

**MENDOCINO/LAKE COUNTIES:** First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; and three Honorable Mention of \$75 each for both age categories (*Note: Classes winning Cash Prizes will not receive an additional \$50 Participation Incentive.*)

- Murals must be received for judging no later than **Friday, March 10, 2023 by 5 PM.** Please deliver your completed mural to the following location:

- Any mural, which is determined by the RRLC Education Committee to be inappropriate, will be disqualified, will not receive the participation award, and will not be displayed at the conference.
