2023 Theme: “TECHNOLOGY DRIVEN – LEGACY HONORED”

RRLC is pleased to announce the theme for the 85th Redwood Region Logging Conference: Technology Driven – Legacy Honored. The logging industry has embraced technology over the years, while still holding the core values and traditions of their legacy and heritage. This theme should prove to be fun for participating classrooms. We look forward to your participation and artistic creativity.

The Redwood Region Logging Conference alternates each year between Eureka and Ukiah. Since the 85th conference will be held in Ukiah, we get to invite you to attend Education Day as well as submit a mural for the contest. We will still be offering your school the opportunity to have a Resource Professional visit your classroom even though your counties will have the opportunity to attend the conference. Our goal is to provide and support you! Here is a brief rundown of what we are offering:

- 1) The 2023 **Mural Contest**- open to grades K through 8th in all Mendocino, Lake, Del Norte, and Humboldt Counties Schools. Contest rules and prizes are attached. Please review the material, indicate your interest on the Forest Education Program Application form, and mail or email it back to us by **December 16, 2022**. Pulp sheets will be delivered to participating classrooms in early January.
- 2) **Education Day** – open to grades 3-6th - will be held on the opening day of the conference, Thursday, March 16, 2023 at the Redwood Empire Fairgrounds in Ukiah. Attendance will be limited to 1,000 Mendocino and Lake County school children. **Bus transportation expenses of up to \$250 will be reimbursed** by the Redwood Region Logging Conference provided the following requirements are met:
 - a) The RRLC Education Day field trip is an approved school activity and is covered by the school’s liability insurance;
 - b) An invoice and supporting documentation is submitted to the RRLC Office by May 15, 2023 for reimbursement. Not to exceed \$250 per bus.

We hope that you will consider these educational opportunities. We look forward to seeing you in 2023!

2023 Mural Contest Rules for Grades K-8th

1. Mural must portray the 2023 Conference theme: **“TECHNOLOGY DRIVEN – LEGACY HONORED.”**
Possible Careers: Forester, Fishery or Wildlife Biologist, Equipment Operator, Yarder Engineer, Logger, Tree Faller, Mill Worker, Welder, Mechanic, Truck Driver, Tree Planter, Drone Pilot, etc.
2. Mural must be created on pulp sheet provided by the Conference. Only one pulp sheet will be provided per classroom.
3. Murals may be created using crayons, watercolors, poster paints, paper collage, or any other unique materials. Use your imagination! Remember, murals will be hung on a wall for display. Murals that are not appropriately designed for wall hanging will not be judged or displayed due to lack of space
4. Murals will be judged on the use of the conference theme, creative use of materials and whole class participation. **The murals should be age appropriate with work done by the students with innovated uses of wood products in the design.** The murals should be a learning experience for students; demonstrating an understanding of the relationship between the forest and everyday life; the sustainability of a managed forest; and the many people working together to fulfill the importance of wood products in our lives.
5. The teacher’s name, grade, school, and telephone number must be on a 3x5 card secured flat on the **bottom right-hand corner** of the mural, facing up with the writing visible. (Please do Not fold and staple)
6. Each class not receiving a cash prize will **RECEIVE \$50!**
7. **PRIZES: The murals will be divided into two grade categories for judging:** K-3rd grades and 4th-8th grades. If you have a 3/4 combination, the mural will be judged in the 4th-8th grade category. Prizes for winning murals in each category are:
HUMBOLDT/DELNORTE/TRINITY COUNTIES: First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; And three Honorable Mention of \$75 each for both age categories. (*Note: Classes winning Cash Prizes will not receive an additional \$50 Participation Reward.*)
MENDOCINO/LAKE COUNTIES: First Place: \$200; Second Place: \$150; Third Place: \$100; and three Honorable Mention of \$75 each for both age categories. (*Note: Classes winning Cash Prizes will not receive an additional \$50 Participation Reward.*)
8. Murals must be received for judging no later than **Friday, March 10, 2023 at 5 PM.** Please deliver your completed mural to the following location:
 - Ukiah: Mendocino County Farm Bureau, 303-C Talmage Rd, Ukiah
9. Murals will be displayed during the Redwood Region Logging Conference, March 16, 17 & 18, 2023.
10. The RRLC reserves the right to reproduce, publish, or publicly display any mural for promotional purposes. RRLC reserves the right to retain ownership of any mural, however, efforts will be made to return the murals.
11. Any mural, which is determined by the RRLC Education Committee to be inappropriate, will be disqualified, will not receive the participation award, and will not be displayed at the conference.
